

Cookie Policy

This policy provides details on the cookies used on Galytix Website.

Definitions

For the purposes of this Cookie Policy:

Company (referred to as either "the Company", "We", "Us" or "Our" in this Agreement) refers to Galytix Limited, Unit 14, Princeton Mews, 167 London Road, Kingston Upon Thames, England, KT2 6PT as well as its subsidiaries / branch(es):

Cookies are small files that are placed on Your computer, mobile device or any other device by a website, containing the details of Your browsing history on that website among its many uses.

Device means any device that can access the Website such as a computer, a cellphone or a digital tablet.

Personal Data is any information that relates to an identified or identifiable individual.

Usage Data refers to data collected automatically, either generated by the use of the Website or from the Website infrastructure itself (for example, the duration of a page visit).

Website refers to Galytix website, accessible from <https://www.galytix.com/>

You means the individual accessing or using the Website, or the company, or other legal entity on behalf of which such individual is accessing or using the Website, as applicable.

What are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files placed on your computer by the websites that you visit. They are commonly used to make websites work, as well as to provide information to the owners of the site.

Categories of cookies

Galytix website (the Website) uses two categories of cookies:

- **Essential Cookies:** these cookies are necessary for the Website to operate. They can allow websites to remember choices You make or to protect you from malicious web applications.
- **Analytical Cookies:** these cookies are used to measure and report on website activity by tracking page visits, visitor locations and how visitors move around the site.
- **Third-Party Cookies:** managed and required by third-party services used on the Website. Additional information about these cookies is available on the providers' websites.

Types of cookies

Cookies created by the Website belong to one of the following types:

- **Session cookies:** these cookies remain in your browser during your browser session only, i.e. until you leave the website.
- **Persistent cookies:** these cookies remain in your browser for a set period of time after the browser session (unless deleted by you).

Why do we use cookies on the Website?

We use the essential cookies to provide You with a better services and user experience.

We use Google Analytics service to collect information about page visits, site navigation, viewed articles, documents and other media files. That helps us identify articles and topics of interest and analyse how easy it is for users to find the relevant content.

We use the collected information to generate reports. The reports contain only aggregated information and do not contain details about individual users.

The following table explains in details the types, categories, and purpose of cookies on the Website.

Galytix	AspNetCore.Antiforgery	Session cookie. Part of a security mechanism to prevent Cross-Site Request Forgery (CSRF) attacks.	Session duration

_ga _ga_RYD0GNYQKE	Google Analytics	Persistent cookie. Used to distinguish unique users by assigning them a randomly generated identifier. This allows website owners to collect and analyse data on user interactions and behaviour, such as the pages visited and the source of the traffic.	2 years
_iidt _vid_t	Fingerprint	Persistent cookies. Used by FingerprintJS (or similar services) to uniquely identify a browser or device across sessions for fraud detection and abuse prevention. They store anonymous identifiers to help distinguish legitimate users from bots or malicious activity.	1 year
ajs_anonymous_id	Analytics.js	Persistent cookie. Assign a unique ID to users who haven't logged in. It helps track anonymous user behavior across sessions for analytics and performance insights without storing personal data.	1 year
